Context:

- ✓ The Apostle Paul *planted* the church in Philippi on his second missionary **journey** around 52 A.D.
- ✓ This is Paul's "thank you" letter in 62 A.D.
- ✓ Paul wrote Philippians from a Roman *prison* while awaiting potential execution.

• Take INVENTORY On Your Mind!

Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, ² then make my joy complete by being **like-minded**, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.

Philippians 2:1-2

Like-minded. Gk phroneo. Having disposition or purpose; of the same mind or habit of thought. to set your affection on, to think, to be <u>single-minded</u>.

- Your Mindset Can Point You Toward Success or Failure.
- If You Think Like Jesus, You Will Begin to LIVE Like Jesus.

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in **humility** value others above yourselves, Philippians 2:3

Humility. Gk *tapeinophrosune.* modesty, humility of <u>mind</u>, lowliness of mind

• Changing Your Mind Toward SelfLESSness.

⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same **mindset as Christ Jesus**: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; ⁷ rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a **servant**, being made in human likeness.

Philippians 2:4-7

Mindset as Jesus. Gk phroneo. i.e. to have the mind of Christ.

Keys to having mind of Christ:

- Heartfelt Surrender.
- Freedom from cycle/pattern of Sin.
- Measurable Spiritual Disciplines.

Servant. *doulos* (doo'-los); a slave, servant. Permanently devoted to do the <u>will</u> of another.

Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done.
