Godliness. a proper response to the things of God, which produces obedience and righteous living. Greek word translated "godliness" in the New Testament means "pious" or "holy".

• Judicial Forgiveness Received past/present/future Confession of Sin.

⁷ In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace ⁸ that he lavished on us. With all wisdom and understanding, Ephesians 1:7-8

Confession: to agree with

⁴ Against you, you only, **have I sinned** and done what is evil in your sight; so you are right in your verdict and justified when you judge. ¹⁰ Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

• Relational Forgiveness Received by Confession Individually. <u>Privately</u>. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

1 John 1:9

• Relational Forgiveness Received by Confession As A Group.

Publically. They stood where they were and read from the Book of the Law of the Lord their God for a quarter of the day, and spent another quarter in confession and in worshiping the Lord their God.

Nehemiah 9:3

The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. **Confessing** their sins, they were baptized by him (John) in the Jordan River.

• Relational Confession of Sin to One Another Leads to Healing.
