• <u>...LIVE</u> for Jesus.

 <sup>15</sup> And Jesus Christ died for all, that those who live should <u>no longer live</u> <u>for themselves</u> but for him who died for them and was raised again.
<sup>16</sup> So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. 2 Corinthians 5:15-16
