- **Partial Surrender Is Talk Without The WALK.**

**Jesus:** <sup>46</sup> "Why do you call me, '**Lord, Lord,**' and do not do what I say?" <sup>47</sup> As for everyone who comes to me and hears my words and puts them into practice, I will show you what they are like. <sup>48</sup> They are like a man building a house, who dug down deep and laid the foundation on rock. When a flood came, the torrent struck that house but could not shake it, because it was well built. <sup>49</sup> But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete." Luke 6:46-49

### SURRENDERING TO JESUS' LORDSHIP IN MY LIFE Cont...

**Key Q: What Is God Leading Me To Surrender?**

- **Fully Surrendered Is When You Walk the TALK.**

**Joseph:** <sup>18</sup> ... Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup> Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly. <sup>20</sup> But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. <sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." <sup>24</sup> When he woke up, **Joseph did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him** and took Mary home as his wife. <sup>25</sup> But he did not consummate their marriage until she gave birth to a son. And he gave him the name Jesus. Matt 1:18-26

**Mary:** <sup>34</sup> "How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?" <sup>37</sup> For no word from God will ever fail." <sup>38</sup> "**I am the Lord's servant,**" Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." Luke 1:34, 38

**Shepherds:**

<sup>15</sup> When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "**Let's go** to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about." <sup>16</sup> **So they hurried off** and found Mary and Joseph, and the baby, who was lying in the manger. <sup>17</sup> When they had seen him, **they spread the word** concerning what had been told them about this child, <sup>18</sup> and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them. <sup>19</sup> But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart. <sup>20</sup> The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had heard and seen, which were just as they had been told.
