Equip & Train Others for Ministry: MBC will be led by men and women using their leadership and spiritual gifts in our church. This includes the concepts of unity, servanthood, spiritual gifts, and ministry callings. We do not believe that the paid pastoral staff is to solely do the work of the ministry. (1 Cor 12 & 14; Rom 12; Eph 4; Psalm 133:1; Neh 1-2; Acts 6:2-5)

Bible-Centered: We believe that the Bible is the inerrant revelation of God's will to us and has the power to transform people's individual lives. The Bible is taught with the expectation that it can be applied to our lives immediately. As we apply the Bible to our lives, we will look and act more like Jesus Christ. (Rom 12:7; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; James 1:23-25)

Unity In our Church: It's paramount to the mission of the church to maintain the unity of God's people. God desires that his church be unified, acknowledging and practicing the equal value of all members of the body. It is impossible for the church to accomplish its mission if each part of the body is not unified and of the same heart and mind. (1 Cor 1:10-17; 1 Cor 12:12-27; Phil 2:1-4 and 1 Peter 4:10)

Reach the Next Generation: We exist to reach our community and the next generation for Christ. The next generation includes 20-somethings; teen; children to nursery ages. We believe that ministries to children and teenagers should be given high priority. We're committed to making MBC a safe place for reaching, encouraging and developing the youth of our area for Christ. (Deuteronomy 6:6-9)

Grow Together in Groups: We believe life-change happens best in the context of small groups. This includes the concepts of discipleship, vulnerability, and accountability with one another. We believe each and every person should be involved in a small group which meet at the church, in homes, through service together and throughout the community. (Luke 6:12-13; Acts 2:44-47)
