Spiritual Gifts Defined:

A spiritual gift is a special ability, given by the Holy Spirit to every <u>BELIEVER</u> at their conversion, to be used to minister to <u>OTHERS</u>.

• We follow <u>JESUS'</u> Example To Serve Using Our Spiritual Gifts.

"...just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many." Matthew 20:28

• The Purpose of My Spiritual Gifts Are To <u>SERVE</u> God.

For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:10

Administration: ... by effectively organizing resources and people in order to efficiently reach ministry goals. 1 Corinthians 12:28

Apostleship: ... start and oversee the development of new ministries and oversee their development. Taking risks sometimes and a willingness 1 Corinthians 12:28

Craftsmanship: ... creatively design or construct items used for ministry. People with this gift enjoy serving with their hands to meet tangible needs for God's glory. Romans 12:7, 28; Exodus 31:3-11

Discernment: ... by recognizing truth or error within a message, person or event. 1 Cor 12:10

Encouragement: ... by helping others to live God-centered lives through inspiration, encouragement, counseling and empowerment. Rom 12:8

Evangelism: ... passionately lead others to the saving knowledge of Christ. Ephesians 4:11

Faith: ... by stepping out in faith in order to see God's purposes accomplished, trusting Him to handle any and all obstacles along the way.1 Corinthians 12:9

Giving: ... by joyfully supporting and funding various kingdom initiatives through material contributions beyond the tithe. Romans 12:8

Healing: ... by healing and restoring to health, beyond traditional and natural means, those who are sick, hurting and suffering. 1 Cor 12:9, 28

Helping: ... by offering others assistance in reaching goals that glorify God and strengthen the body of Christ. This aptitude is sometimes referred to as the gift of "helps" or "service." Romans 12:7, 28 (NIV) **Hospitality:** ... make others, especially strangers, feel warmly welcomed, accepted, and comfortable in the church family. The ability to coordinate factors that promote fellowship. Romans 12:13

Intercession: ... praying for the needs of others in the church family over extended periods of time on a regular basis. The ability to persist in prayer and not be discouraged until the answer arrives. Col. 1:9

Knowledge: ... communicating God's truth to others in a way that promotes justice, honesty and understanding. 1 Corinthians 12:7-8

Leadership: ... by casting vision, stimulating spiritual growth, applying strategies and achieving success where God's purposes are concerned. Romans 12:8

Mercy: ... by ministering to those who suffer physically, emotionally, spiritually or relationally. Their actions are characterized by love, care, compassion and kindness toward others. Romans 12:8

Miracles: ...through supernatural acts that bring validity to God and His power. 1 Corinthians 12:10, 28

Prophecy: ... offering messages from God that comfort, encourage, guide, warn or reveal sin in a way that leads to repentance and spiritual growth. Greek word is "to speak forth the truth." The gift of prophecy includes both "forth telling" (preaching) and "foretelling" (revelation). 1Cor 12:28

Shepherding: The God-given special ability to overseeing, training, feeding, coaching/leading the body of Christ. Ephesians 4:11

Teaching: The God-given special ability to serve and strengthen the body of Christ by teaching sound doctrine in relevant ways, empowering people to gain a sound and mature spiritual education. 1 Corinthians 12:28

Tongues: The God-given special ability to serve and strengthen the body of Christ by communicating God's message in a special language unknown to the speaker. 1 Corinthians 12:10, 28

Wisdom: ... by making wise decisions and counseling others with sound advice, all in accordance with God's will. 1 Corinthians 12:8
